#### **Menstrual Health Management (MHM)**

A menstrual health awareness session was conducted separately for both boys and girls to provide accurate information and promote understanding about menstruation.

For **girls**, the session focused on the biological process, proper hygiene practices, and ways to maintain comfort and confidence during menstruation. It aimed to empower them with knowledge and reduce hesitation in discussing menstrual health.

For **boys**, the session emphasized understanding menstruation as a natural process, promoting empathy, respect, and support for their peers. It helped dispel myths and encouraged positive attitudes toward menstrual health.

Both sessions successfully broke taboos and fostered open communication, awareness, and mutual respect among students.
